This report reflects the dedication and effort put forth by health department staff, the Board of Health, the Lenawee County Board of Commissioners, Lenawee County Administration and the many community partners that work together to improve the health of the citizens of Lenawee County. A few of the highlights from 2019 include;

- Responded to the statewide Hepatitis A outbreak.
- Continued implementation of our Strategic Planning Initiative, identifying four priority areas
 - Overweight & Obesity
 - Opioid Abuse
 - Chronic Diseases
 - Adverse Childhood Experiences
- Partnered with the community to develop a Call to Action to Reduce Prescription Drug and Opiate Addiction.
- Utilized social media platforms Twitter and Facebook to promote awareness and provide education regarding overweight and obesity and opioid addiction.
- Partnered with Community Action Agency to connect families to lead remediation resources.
- Expanded the free condom distribution campaign; distributed 10,238 condoms across 20 sites in Lenawee County.
